directions

Take Exit #236 (old Exit#35) off Interstate 80. Go north on State Route 487, approximately 10.5 miles. After passing the Fishing Creek Maintenance Building (on the right), turn right onto Zaners Bridge Road. The camp is located on the right just after you cross Zaners Bridge.

housing

At Family Camp, you can sleep in the dorms or bring a tent, RV, or camper. There are separate male and female dorms and a family dorm with separate bathrooms. Children must be accompanied by an adult if sleeping in the dorms. There are a limited number of RV sites with water and electricity. Please indicate your desired sleeping accommodations on your registration form. All spaces are allotted on a first register and reserved(deposit included) basis.

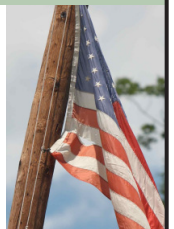
